



## Yangon-Inlay-Bagan-Yangon (6Days / 5Night)

### DAY 1- YANGON

Upon arrival at Yangon international airport, welcomed by our guide and transferred to your hotel. Overnight at hotel in Yangon.

### DAY 2- YANGON-HEHO-INLE LAKE (By flight) (B, L, D)

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to the airport for the flight to Heho. Arrive to Heho and drive to Nyangshwe, the gateway village to the Inle Lake. Along the way, stop at the Shwe Yan Pyay Monastery which features carvings and a collection of Buddha images. Observe the local Intha people who's rowing by the one-legged in lake and see their floating garden. Visit the Phaung Daw Oo Pagoda which enshrines five Buddha images covered in gold leaf and the Nga Phe Kyaung Monastery which famous for its jumping cats trained by monks . Enjoy your lunch and dinner at local restaurants. Overnight at the hotel in Inle.



### DAY 3-INLE-BAGAN (By flight) (B, L, D)

After breakfast at hotel, transfer to the Heho airport for your flight to Bagan. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel for a quick freshen-up and start sightseeing with the busy Nyaung Oo local market. The journey continues with a visit to religious monuments over the surrounding plains. We will start to visit to a diverse selection of the most famous Pagodas and Temple, such as Shwezigon Pagoda, Ananda Temple, and Kubyauk Gyi. Afterwards we will go to Shwesandaw Stupa to watch sunset. Enjoy your lunch and dinner at local restaurants. (Optional: sunset cruise ride of the Ayerwaddy river). Overnight at the hotel in Bagan.



### DAY 4-BAGAN (B, L, D)

After breakfast at hotel, excursion to Bagan Museum and observe the process of traditional lacquerware, one of Myanmar's best-known handicrafts and a specialty of Bagan. Next, Dhammayangyi, a massive-looking temple dating from 1170 that is famous for its interlocking mortar less brickwork and then visit Sulamani, one of Bagan's great two-storied Bamar style temples, which has 4-seated Buddha images. sunset in the vicinity of Bagan's ancient monuments. (Optional: Balloon ride over the pagodas of Bagan). Enjoy your lunch and dinner at local restaurants and overnight at the hotel in Bagan.

### **DAY 5-BAGAN-YANGON (By flight) (B, L, D)**

After breakfast at hotel, our driver meets you at hotel and transfer to Nyaung U Airport for your flight to Yangon. Upon arrival to Yangon, sightseeing starts to Bogyoke (Scotts) Market, formerly known as Scott's Market; the biggest market in yangon stuffed with hundreds of handicraft, gemstone, art, food and clothes stores. (Note: Market is closed on Mondays and public holidays). After lunch we'll visit Kyaukhtatgyi Pagoda (70meters long reclining Buddha) where you can find the great overview of Buddhism with murals depicting the life of Buddha. You will then have a chance to experience part of local life at local tea shop. Next your guide will bring you to the 2,500 years old magnificent Shwedagon pagoda which is the most venerable pagoda in Myanmar and sheathed in 11 tons of pure gold. Enjoy sunset views of the golden stupa from this vantage point before you return to your hotel.
