



Yangon-Mandalay-Amarapura-Sagaing-Awa- Bagan-Inle-Indein-Ngapali-Yangon (14 Days / 13 Nights)

DAY 1-YANGON-MANDALAY

(By overnight Express bus)

Arrival at Yangon International Airport, welcomed by our guide and discovery begins to Botataung Pagoda and explore the daily lives of people around jetty and Yangon River view for photoshoot. You will then have a chance to experience part of local life at local tea shop. Enjoy a delicious dinner in this evening at local restaurant and transfer to express bus station to Mandalay. Overnight on bus.

DAY 2-MANDALAY-AMARAPURA-SAGAING-AWA (By private Car) (B, L, D)

Upon arrival to Mandalay, heading out to Mandalay's outskirts; the city of Amarapura which means "city of immortality", Mahagandaryon Monastery (Buddhistic University), followed by Soon U Ponya Shin Pagoda which brings some serious panoramic views from the top of the Sagaing hill, U Min Thonze or 30 Caves with a crescent shaped colonnade of arches and Buddha statues, and then Continue to Ava area which the three main attractions including Bagaya Kyaung (Teak Monastery), the Ava Palace site (Watch Tower) and Me Nu's Brick Monastery (Me Nu Ok Kyaung). On the return journey we again pass through Amarapura just in time for sunset at the iconic U Bein Bridge that was built around 1850 and is believed to be the oldest and longest teakwood bridge in the world before return to the hotel in Mandalay.



DAY 3-MANDALAY (B, L,D)

After breakfast at hotel, sightseeing starts to visit the most venerated Mahamuni Buddha image, Myanmar traditional handicrafts work shop, Shwesandaw Monastery noted for its exquisite wood carving ,Kuthodaw known as the world's Biggest book and its 729 stone slab of Buddhist scripture enjoy the sunset from Mandalay hill, magnificent view of the city and surrounding side. Take a dinner at local restaurant and transfer to express bus station to Bagan. Overnight on bus.

DAY 4-BAGAN (B, L,D)

Upon arrival to Bagan, start sightseeing with the busy Nyaung Oo local market. The journey continues with a visit to religious monuments over the surrounding plains. We will start to visit to a diverse selection of the most famous Pagodas and Temple, such as Shwezigon Pagoda, Ananda Temple, and Kubyauk Gyi. Afterwards we will go to Shwesandaw Stupa to watch sunset. Enjoy your lunch and dinner at local restaurants. (Optional: sunset cruise ride of the Ayerwaddy river or sun raise Balloon ride over the pagodas of Bagan) Overnight at the hotel in Bagan.



DAY 5-BAGAN-MT.POPA-BAGAN (By private Car) (B, L, D)

After breakfast at hotel, excursion to Mount Popa where you can learn about the legends about Nats represent a heritage of earlier animist religions in Burmese countryside. From the top of Popa Taung Kalat can enjoy a panoramic view. The surrounding areas are arid, but the MT.Popa area has over 200 springs and streams. It is therefore likened to an oasis in the desert-like dry central zone of Myanmar. On the way back to Bagan and learn the daily life of the people among the palm trees. Observe the process of traditional lacquerware, one of Myanmar's best-known handicrafts and a specialty of Bagan. Experience a sunset in the vicinity of Bagan's ancient monuments. Enjoy your lunch and dinner at local restaurants. Overnight at the hotel, Bagan.



DAY 6-BAGAN - INLE (By overnight Express bus) (B, L, D)

After breakfast at hotel, excursion to Bagan Museum and observe the process of traditional lacquerware, one of Myanmar's best-known handicrafts and a specialty of Bagan. Next, Dhammayangyi, a massive-looking temple dating from 1170 that is famous for its interlocking mortar less brickwork and then visit Sulamani, one of Bagan's great two-storied Bamar style temples, which has 4-seated Buddha images. Enjoy your lunch and dinner at local restaurants. In the evening, transfer to the bus terminal to Nyangshwe/Inle. Overnight on bus. (Estimate Departure time: 8:30pm and arrival time: 3/4 am)

**Please take note the zone fee (USD10/pax) will be collected from traveller on the bus upon arrival to Nyangshwe.

DAY 7- INLE (B,L, D)

After breakfast at Hotel, observe the local Intha people who rows by the one-legged in lake and see their floating garden. Take a day boat tour around the lake to observe the floating market, hand-weaving silk and Buddhist temples. Visit the Phaung Daw Oo Pagoda which enshrines five Buddha images covered in gold leaf and the Nga Phe Kyaung Monastery which famous for its jumping cats trained by monks . Enjoy your lunch and dinner at local restaurants. Overnight at the hotel, Nyaung Shwe.



****Remark:** Early morning express bus arrival pick up will be by own arrangement for the package without hotel stay.

DAY 8- INLE-INDEIN (By Boat) (B,L, D)

After the breakfast at hotel, we will be taking a boat trip to the southern part down side which lead into a small twist and turn creek running into the lake, then we will reach the Indein village. Indein village is small in size and located at the south western bank of the lake itself and it is popular for its ruined clusters of pagodas dated back to 16th century. The environment around the village will bring everyone centuries back. There will be a free time where all visitors can freely go around for sightseeing purpose and have a chance to get to know friendly local people Enjoy your lunch and dinner at local restaurants. Overnight at the hotel, Nyaung Shwe.

DAY 9-INLE-NGAPALI (By Flight) (B)

After breakfast at hotel, transfer to HEHO airport for your flight to Ngapali. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel and enjoy your leisure time. Free and Easy.

DAY 11- NGAPALI -YANGON (By flight) (B, L, D)

After breakfast at hotel, our driver meets you at hotel and transfer to Sittwe Airport for your flight to Yangon. Upon arrival, visit to Mahabondoola Park and Myanmar Independence monument. After lunch we'll visit Kyaukhtatgyi Pagoda (70meters long reclining Buddha) where you can find the great overview of Buddhism with murals depicting the life of Buddha. You will then

have a chance to experience part of local life at local tea shop. Next your guide will bring you to the 2,500 years old magnificent Shwedagon pagoda which is the most venerable pagoda in Myanmar and sheathed in 11 tons of pure gold. Enjoy sunset views of the golden stupa from this vantage point before you return to your hotel.

DAY 12-YANGON (B, L,D)

After breakfast at hotel, our guide and driver will pick you up at your hotel and the journey will start to Sule Pagoda in the middle of downtown, strand road and then heading to Bogyoke Market, formerly known as Scott's Market; the biggest market in yangon stuffed with hundreds of handicraft, gemstone, art, food and clothes stores. Kandawgyi Park is one of central Yangon's greenest spots. You will see the glittering Karaweil barge. Overnight at hotel in Yangon.
